Perform mechanical work and assist other pump station operators in the installation, repair, and maintenance of mechanical equipment and associated gear within the wastewater collection system.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Lift up to 50 lbs. (medium)
- Occasional heavy lifting, routine bending, climbing, turning of valves, and confined space entry required

WORK ENVIRONMENT

Indoors and outdoors in various climates and conditions, including exposure to wastewater, noise, heat, cold, dust, chemicals, and other hazardous conditions.

EMERGENCY EVENTS

Required to work during emergency events.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Perform general maintenance and repairs on all wastewater pumping equipment, machinery, and/or other equipment in conjunction with established maintenance schedules and requests and on an as needed basis.
- Perform ground maintenance.
- Temporarily replace other pump station operators and work with line crew when required.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must adhere to all safety rules and regulations.
- Ability to read and interpret written and oral instructions.
- Ability to comprehend the mechanics/operation of wastewater pumping equipment.
- Must maintain phone service for emergency call-out purposes.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

- High school diploma or equivalent (GED) required.
- Minimum of one year of mechanical experience preferred.
- LA DHH-OPH Wastewater Collection Certification required or ability to attain.
- Must possess and maintain valid Louisiana driver's license.
