The Chairman, Mr. J. Amedée, called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. in the Terrebonne Parish Council Meeting Room. The Chairman then led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance. The Chairman recognized Terrebonne Parish Sheriff Timothy Soignet who gave a brief explanation of the Sheriff's Office's preparedness plan for the upcoming hurricane season; highlighting better fuel capabilities, new trucks, emergency shelters for officers, and temporary holding units for looters. He then noted that they will be partnering with churches who can receive supplies to help care for the communities after the storm and that sheriff's deputies and their families are also completing hurricane preparedness measures as well.

The Chairman recognized TOHSEP Director Earl Eues who gave an update on hurricane preparedness, sharing that his office, along with local and state agencies, as well as, all utility companies, had completed a hurricane exercise on May 21st, which included at least ninety (90) people in attendance. He then shared that the new services contract for this upcoming hurricane season is an all-purpose contract covering for a variety of needs, then reviewed other services being prepared to respond to emergencies.

The Chairman recognized the HPD Chief Travis Theriot who gave a brief overview of his department's Hurricane Preparedness Plan.

The Chairman recognized Parish President Jason Bergeron who presented a public service announcement on hurricane preparedness for parish citizens.

WHEREAS, the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, hereby declares that it has adopted a resolution giving notice of intent to adopt the following ordinance hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, has conducted a public hearing on Wednesday, June 26, 2024; and

WHEREAS, after considering all comments received, if any, the following action is hereby taken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government, that the Zoning Map of the Parish of Terrebonne be hereby amended so as to rezone from R-1 (Single-Family Residential) to R-2 (Two – Family Residential), Lot 35, Block 2 and Lot 36, Block 3, Henderson Park Subdivision, 237 Henderson Street, Houma, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Hotel/Motel Tax has been allocated by the Downtown Development Board for beautification and operations of the Folklife Cultural Museum and to help maintain the existing buildings, parks, and the Court Square in the Historic District, as well as advertising to market Houma's Historic District attractions.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Terrebonne Parish Council, on behalf of the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government that the 2024 Adopted Budget be amended to adjust various Downtown Development Corporation Accounts. (**Attachment A**)

WHEREAS, Administration is requesting funding of \$116,248 for Pollution Control extension of the Gray Sewer line, and

WHEREAS, the funding is from the Sewer Capital Additions net position.

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING AND ACCEPTING THE MAINTENANCE/OPERATION OF THE STREET(S), DRAINAGE SERVITUDES, SEWER, AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY FOR "ADLEY OAKS SUBDIVISION, PHASE C;" ENERGIZE AND ACCEPT THE STREETLIGHTS; AND TO INCORPORATE "RED KNOT DRIVE" AND THE EXTENSION OF "ADLEY AVENUE" INTO THE ENHANCED 911 EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A BETTER MEANS OF LOCATING ADDRESSES; AND TO SET FORTH AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE INCORPORATION OF STREET NAME(S), TO INFORM THE PROPER AGENCIES OF THE STREET NAME(S), AND TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF THE

SECTION I

ORDINANCE NO. 9593

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE AS SURPLUS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE TERREBONNE PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT TO DONATE FOUR (4) TRANSIT BUSES NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES TO TERREBONNE COUNCIL ON AGING, INC. FOR USE IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF THE ELDERLY IN TERREBONNE PARISH, LOUISIANA, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE TERREBONNE PARISH PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE DONATION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS.

SECTION I

WHEREAS, Section 1-06 of the Home Rule Charter for the Parish of Terrebonne provides that the parish government shall have the right, power and authority to pass all ordinances requisite or necessary to promote, protect and preserve the general welfare, safety, health, peace and good order of the parish, including, but not by way of limitation, the right, power and authority to pass ordinances on all subject matter necessary, requisite or proper for the management of the parish affairs, and all other subject matter without exception, subject only to the limitations that the same shall not be inconsistent with the Constitution or expressly denied by the general law applicable to the parish; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Constitutional article VII, Section 14, Part B(1) authorizes the TPCG to use "public funds for programs of social welfare for the aid and support of the needy";

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute 33:1236(11)(a) further authorizes the TPCG to "provide for the support of the poor and necessitous within [its] parish"; and

WHEREAS, Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government is in possession of four (4) transit buses, more fully described below, which were previously used in the Good Earth Transit system, and have now exceeded their useful life and have been removed from the rural transit program by the LA DOTD:
