SUMMARY:

Assists Staff Engineers/Engineers in the management of Capital Projects and scheduling work so that assigned projects are completed in a timely manner. Performs engineering research and design work of a routine nature under the direct supervision of an engineer. Assists with the creation and maintenance of numerous GIS layers including but are not limited to layers such as culverts, catch basins, rights-of-ways, forced drainage, subdivisions, streets etc.

BASIC FUNCTIONS:
