### **SUMMARY:**

Under the direct supervision of the Operations Supervisor and under the general supervision of the Road & Bridge Superintendent. The Bridge Mechanic is responsible for insuring proper maintenance of all Parish Bridges.

### **BASIC FUNCTIONS:**

1. Delegate daily work/maintenance to mechanic crew.
2. Performs general maintenance and minor repairs on all Parish Bridges as required.
3. Inspects bridges for damage or potential damage on bridges when not on a specific assignment.
4. Reports all required repair parts and equipment to Supervisor or Superintendent.
5. Relieves Bridge Tenders when necessary.
6. Assists Operations Supervisor in all tasks as directed.
7. Carries out duties of Operations Supervisor in case of his absence.
8. Must be able to learn and practice all applicable safety rules and regulations.
9. Exposed to adverse conditions and loud noises.

### **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Tier 1 employee
2. Must have a valid Louisiana vehicle operator's license.
3. Must have good oral and written communication skills.
4. Must be able to work extra hours as required by the Supervisor or Superintendent, as required to meet Division work load, or as required in emergencies.
5. Must have thorough knowledge of Terrebonne Parish and all bridge locations within.
6. Heavy lifting required.
7. Occasional work in tight and confined spaces.
8. Routine climbing in excess of 100 feet involved.

### **EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**

1. High School Diploma or equivalent.
2. Must have a minimum of 2 (two) years' experience with a mechanical background or 1 (one) year experience as a bridge mechanic trainee.
3. Must have thorough knowledge of the occupational hazards and precautions necessary for safe operation and repair of assigned equipment.
4. Must have the ability to comprehend the mechanics and operational procedures of assigned equipment.
5. Must have the ability to read and interpret written and oral instructions including electrical diagrams.
