SUMMARY:

The Juvenile Care Associates directly oversee the daily activities of the juveniles housed in the facility.

BASIC FUNCTIONS:

The responsibilities of the Juvenile Care Associates will include the following:

- 1. Supervise the detention, recreation, daily activities, and classroom activities of the juveniles housed in the Terrebonne Parish Juvenile Detention Center.
- 2. Strictly adhere to policy and procedures of the Terrebonne Parish Juvenile Detention Center.
- 3. Shall supervise the daily activities of the juveniles housed in the facility.
- 4. Shall complete all necessary reports.
- 5. Assist with laundry details when called to do so.
- 6. Shall run the control boards (Main and Pod Control) as part of a daily rotation.
- 7. Shall assist transportation department when called upon to do so.
- 8. Shall supervise cleaning assignments of the juveniles housed in the facility.
- 9. Shall attend any training required and necessary for effective job performance.
- 10. On occasion, the position will require the ability to **restrain combative** juveniles and defend oneself through **dynamic** movement and defensive tactics, which may incorporate ground level restraint and ground defensive techniques.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Shall perform any duties not in the job description, but located within the policy and procedure manual and necessary for the smooth operation of the facility.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- 1. The candidate shall have at least a high school diploma or a GED equivalent.
- 2. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing.
- 3. The candidate shall have a **strong desire** to work with troubled youth in an **energetic positive** manner.
- 4. The candidate shall clear a criminal background check conducted by the Louisiana State Police and pass a drug screen.
