4. Approach projects holistically to fully understand the impact of changes on extendibility, scalability, performance, and maintainability.
5. Analyze issues and prioritize efficiently while taking an analytical and methodical approach to problem solving.
6. Maintain continuous and up-to-date knowledge on rapidly-changing development technology trends and new releases to make suggestions for product efficiency.
7. Manage simultaneous projects while delivering results and meeting deadlines.
8. Develop both client-side and server-side code for dynamic web applications using modern frameworks and tools.
9. Use source control tools to develop code concurrently with other team members and track changes made to projects over time.
10. Interact with and interpret data from multiple databases and data sources.
11. Analyze current applications including performance, diagnosis, and trouble-shooting of problems, and implement innovative solutions to improve their efficiency while ensuring that user requirements are met.
12. Train users in the use of developed applications and assist users with application problems.
13. Learn RPG to maintain legacy applications and convert into web applications.
