SUMMARY:

Under the direct supervision of the Vegetation Operations Supervisor, Field Technician II performs manual work of a semi-skilled nature. However, repetitive duties may be performed under general supervision. Field Technician II – Vegetation is responsible for cutting grass and maintaining trees and/or bushes on public right away.

BASIC FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Required to cut grass and maintain trees and bushes throughout the parish on public right away.
- 2. Willing to learn how to operate other heavy equipment in order to relieve or substitute for other equipment operators.
- 3. Must be courteous when dealing with the public.
- 4. Must be able to learn and practice all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- 5. Must be willing to work overtime including nights, weekends, and holidays and in other areas of division as needed.
- 6. Must possess a good working knowledge of equipment assigned.
- 7. Performs general maintenance and minor repairs on equipment as directed.
- 8. Performs all other duties as assigned or deemed necessary by supervisor.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Ability to comprehend the operation of Vegetation Division.
- 2. Ability to read and interpret written and oral instructions.
- 3. Ability to use a computer for daily assignments.
- 4. Must possess valid LA Driver's License.
- 5. Must have and maintain telephone service for emergency call-out purposes.
- 6. Works indoors and outdoors to maintain facilities with frequent exposure to noise, heat, dust, inclement weather, odorous conditions, and other hazardous conditions.
- 7. Occasional heavy lifting of 50lb to 75lb required, routine bending, climbing.

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- 1. High school diploma or equivalency certificate preferred.
- 2. Must be able to read and write sufficiently to understand and carry out basic instructions.
