### **SUMMARY:**

Under the direct supervision of the Operations Supervisor and the general supervision of the Road & Bridge Superintendent. The incumbent is responsible for the shelling of all unpaved streets and road shoulders deemed necessary by the Supervisor or Superintendent.

### **BASIC FUNCTIONS:**

1. Operates Dump Truck effectively in all tasks assigned by the Supervisor or Superintendent.
2. Maintains Dump Truck and reports all problems to Supervisor or Superintendent.
3. Exercises reasonable care in truck operation.
4. Maintains proper shelling on all unpaved roads in the Parish as well as all road shoulders under daily supervision of the Operations Supervisor.
5. Performs duties, which may be required of him, other than truck driving, as directed.
6. Must have the ability to practice all applicable safety rules and regulations.
7. Must have a fairly thorough knowledge of the Parish roads.
8. Must be willing to work extra hours as necessary and any emergency situation such as Hurricanes, Ice Events, or any other situation deemed necessary by Administration.
9. Must be capable of tailgating shells.

### **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must have and maintain a current CDL Driver's License.
2. Must display some mechanical ability.
3. Must be capable and willing to work with other personnel.
4. Must be capable of learning and practicing safety rules and regulations.
5. Must have some Dump Truck maintenance knowledge to keep machine in working order.
6. Must be capable of lifting 75 lbs. - 100 lbs.

### **EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE:**

1. Must have a high school education.
2. Must be capable of reading & writing sufficiently to understand and carry out basic instructions.
3. Must be able to operate a 13-speed transmission.
