- 3. Assist mechanic with major repair work.
- 4. Analyze work sites to ensure equipment can operate safely.
- 5. Report breakdowns and emergencies to supervisor.
- 6. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Learn, practice, and enforce all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- 2. Possess general knowledge of principles of supervision.
- 3. Possess knowledge of equipment maintenance.
- 4. Ability to operate chain saws, shovels, and various small tools.
- 5. Ability to read and write sufficiently to fill out reports.
- 6. Ability to follow written and oral instructions.
- 7. Ability to supervise subordinates.
- 8. Ability to operate tablet or iPad.
