### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- 1. Operate and maintain the marsh buggy excavator for the purpose of maintaining the parish-wide drainage system.
- 2. Perform the following duties: excavating, ditch sloping, constructing and sloping of levees, driving pilings, clearing bayous, and ensuring proper depths.
- 3. Ensure proper maintenance of equipment oil levels, air filters, lubricants, etc.
- 4. Supervise work and train assistants in equipment operation.
- 5. Perform some mechanic work to correct minor breakdowns on job sites and assist mechanic with major repair work.
- 6. Analyze work sites to ensure equipment can operate safely.
- 7. Report breakdowns and emergencies to supervisor.
- 8. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Learn and practice all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- 2. Possess general knowledge of principles of supervision.
- 3. Ability to load and unload marsh buggy excavator onto low-boy.
- 4. Ability to use a torch.
- 5. Ability to operate jon boat to access sites, haul fuel, etc.
- 6. Ability to read and write sufficiently to fill out reports.
- 7. Ability to follow written and oral instructions.
