# **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- 2. Perform general maintenance work on all equipment in conjunction with established maintenance schedules, requests, and on an as needed basis.
- 3. Perform ground maintenance and temporarily replace other mechanics when required.
- 4. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.
- 5. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

# **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**
