ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Operating a street sweeper to achieve the systematic cleaning of selected streets and catch basins in Terrebonne Parish.
- Prepare and maintain daily reports and records required for proper maintenance of equipment used and maintain street sweeping schedule submitted by supervisor.
- Perform general maintenance and repairs on equipment as directed and possess good working knowledge of equipment to efficiently operate all equipment assigned.
- Learn how to operate other heavy equipment in order that you may substitute for other operators within the division.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to operate street sweeper, pickup trucks, tools, and any other equipment that is required to perform job functions.
- Must have mechanical aptitude and the willingness to learn the operations of machines.
- Must practice and enforce all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- Have a good working knowledge of the areas of Terrebonne Parish and the City of Houma.
- Must have good communication skills and be able to read and write sufficiently to carry out basic instructions.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

- High school diploma or GED certificate required.
- A minimum of one year of appropriate and responsible experience in the field of operating heavy equipment is preferable.
- Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana Class B commercial driver's license (CDL).
