# **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS**

- Operate paratransit bus for the safety and comfort of passengers. Assist non-ambulatory patrons with boarding and using the paratransit bus safely and ensure wheelchairs are properly secured.
- Complete pre-trip inspection reports, as well as various other forms required by the Transit Division.
- Inspect bus for mechanical defects to ensure safe operation. Refuel vehicles and check oil and other fluids as needed.
- Accept fares using automated collection machines.
- Maintain tightly scheduled bus timetable while maintaining safe operation standards.
- Operate two-way communication radios and other electronic devices according to Transit Division policies.
- Assist with evacuation and reentry of the public before and after emergency events.
- Follow safety and security policies and procedures with regards to passenger safety and security, vehicular accidents, on-the-job personal injuries, and accident or injury reporting procedures.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

# **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Work any vehicle, schedule, or route as required by the Transit Division.
- Knowledge of the Houma and Thibodaux areas to operate vehicle and provide travel information to residents and tourists.
- Maintain good driving record.
- Read and write legibly.
- Follow and enforce transit policies and procedures.
- Drive large/wide vehicles without hitting curbs, signs, or other fixed objects.
- Attend paid training sessions on weekends or other days as required.
- Possess and use an accurate watch set to official transit time.
- Position is a Safety Sensitive position and is subject to random drug testing.

# **EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES**

- High school diploma or GED certificate preferred.
- Experience operating heavy-duty vehicles preferred.
- Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana class D chauffeur driver's license.
