ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Operate and maintain assigned dump truck and report all mechanical problems to immediate supervisor for repairs.
- Exercise reasonable care in truck operation.
- Learn basic use of surveyor level to set grades on ditches and culverts.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Learn and practice applicable safety rules and regulations.
- Knowledge of Terrebonne Parish roads.
- Knowledge of dump truck maintenance and ability to keep machine in working order.
- Ability to work well with other personnel.
- Capable of reading and writing sufficiently to understand and carry out basic instructions.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

- High school diploma or GED certificate required.
- Proof of experience in operating large trucks.
- Possess and maintain valid Louisiana class B commercial driver's license (CDL).
