- Rewire electrical pumps.
- Replace electrical motors in pump stations.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Be capable of following all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- Be capable of reading and writing to fill out reports and read wiring blueprints.
- Be capable of understanding and following municipal and parish codes.
- Be capable of operating mobile tablet or computer.
