

Employers Wanted for High-School Job Fair

HOUMA – More than 500 public high-school students will be graduating in May with industry-based certifications, and many will be seeking employment at a job fair April 11, 2019, at the Houma Municipal Auditorium.

Those industry-based certifications are in business/computer applications, health care, welding, carpentry, hospitality, electrical skills, safety, customer service and other fields.

These same students will have WorkKeys certificates in applied math, graphic literacy and workplace documents, so potential employers can get an idea of their level of problem-solving and critical-thinking skills, as well as trainability.

The job fair begins at 8:30 a.m. with students arriving directly from the high schools; concluding by midday.
