Terrebbonne General Medical Center and Terrebbonne Parish Consolidated Government are partnering to provide COVID-19 vaccines at the Houma-Terrebbonne Civic Center. The drive-through process will be quick and efficient allowing community members to remain in their vehicles to receive the vaccine. Drive-through vaccine distribution began today, Tuesday, January 19, and over 200 vaccines were provided.

TGMC President and CEO, Phyllis Peoples, and Parish President Gordon Dove have always worked together and the COVID pandemic was no exception. “The Parish and Terrebbonne General Medical Center are proud to be working together to provide COVID-19 vaccinations to the people in our community safely and conveniently. The vaccination distribution is part of the phased rollout of the COVID-19 vaccine that is following guidelines set by the state and the Louisiana Department of Health. The vaccine is currently available for those in Phase 1B (ages 70 and older).
