14.30. Domestic Preferences for Procurements – As appropriate, and to the extent consistent with law, the contractor should, to the greatest extent practicable, provide a preference for the purchase, acquisition, or use of goods, products, or materials produced in the United States. This includes, but is not limited to iron, aluminum, steel, cement, and other manufactured products.

For purposes of this clause:

Produced in the United States means, for iron and steel products, that all manufacturing processes, from the initial melting stage through the application of coatings, occurred in the United States.

Manufactured products mean items and construction materials composed in whole or in part of non-ferrous metals such as aluminum; plastics and polymer-based products such as polyvinyl chloride pipe; aggregates such as concrete; glass, including optical fiber; and lumber."

	Question: Does the bridge operate sufficiently to lower the lift span and raise the counterweight? The design includes provisions to temporarily support the counterweight in the 'counterweight up' position. Can the contractor rely on the normal operation of the bridge to raise the counterweight to the 'up' position and use the temporary support system as specified in the plan set, without the need for additional lifting methods to achieve the temporary support elevation limits? Answer: You should only need to lower the span once to remove the counterweights so you can use the bridge controls and engage the starters as needed.			
	Question: Do the FEMA provisions apply to all items or only to the quantities as noted by (FEMA PARTICIPATING)? Some base bid items include (FEMA PARTICIPATING) in the description and other do not. Are all base bid items FEMA Participating?
