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COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT & RESTORATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES OF September 3, 2024

1. Chairman Ernie Babin called the regular meeting of the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee to order at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 3, 2024, in the Council Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, Government Tower. Chairman Babin led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Upon roll call, present were Tony Antill, Ernie Babin, Jeff DeBlieux, Merlin Lirette, Jan Rogers, Barry Soudelier, Mavin Steward, and Mickey Thomas. Absent: Matt Benoit. Also present was Mr. Mart Black, Director of the Terrebonne Parish Office of Coastal Restoration.
3. Mr. Soudelier moved, seconded by Mr. Rogers, "THAT the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee **accepts** the minutes for the meeting of Aug. 6, 2024." *NO OPPOSITON, MOTION CARRIED, CHAIRMAN DECLARED MOTION ADOPTED.*
4. New Business:

Local Concern Applications: -

- The Chairman called to order the local concern application for Ross J. Ross/R&M Residential Rentals LLC; Proposed to reclaim 10 feet of eroded land from Bayouside by digging soil from the adjacent Company Canal at 229 Texas Gulf Road, Bourg, LA; Terrebonne Parish, LA P20240625 – Public Notices ends – Sept. 9, 2024.

Mr. Black informed the Committee that we were waiting on comments from the Terrebonne Parish Public Works Department on the servitude in the proposed area. Mr. Black recommends putting this permit on hold until next month.

Discussion was held on this permit.

Mr. DeBlieux moved, seconded by Mr. Rogers, "THAT the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee **hold** the issuance of a Coastal Impact Certificate and Coastal Use Permit for P20240625 submitted by Ross J. Ross/R&M Residential Renters LLC" *NO OPPOSITON, MOTION CARRIED, CHAIRMAN DECLARED MOTION ADOPTED.*

- The Chairman called to order the local concern application for Phillip Fanguy; Proposed Borrow Pit at 4390 & 4394 Hwy. 56 Houma, LA; Terrebonne Parish, LA P20240458 – Public Notices ends – Sept. 9, 2024.

Mr. Black informed the Committee that this area is Upland, but the property is narrow, and it's located on Hwy 56 in front of the Klondike Bridge. Mr. Black recommended a Coastal Use Permit with these conditions – must stay no closer than 20ft from property line, must keep Hwy. 56 free of mud & dirt within ½ mile of access road, & follow all state & local signing requirements, Critical due to proximity to Klondike Bridge.

Discussion was held on this permit.

Vice-Chairman Thomas stated that after an extended discussion, the Committee requests a plat showing the property's dimensions from the landowner and this permit to be put on hold until next month.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Soudelier, "THAT the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee **hold** the issuance of a Coastal Impact Certificate and Coastal Use Permit for

P20240629 submitted by Phillip Fanguy” *NO OPPOSTITON, MOTION CARRIED, CHAIRMAN DECLARED MOTION ADOPTED.*

- The Chairman called to order the local concern application for Apache Louisiana Minerals LLC; Proposed Borrow Pit for future lifts of the Morganza to the Gulf Reah B levee; Section 13, T19S-R16E; Terrebonne Parish, LA P20240673 – No Public Notices Ends Sept. 23, 2024.

Mr. Black informed the Committee that this permit be postponed until the determination of State/Local Concern by LDENR.

Discussion was held on this permit.

Mr. Thomas moved, seconded by Mr. Soudelier, “THAT the Coastal Zone Management & Restoration Advisory Committee **hold** the issuance of a Coastal Impact Certificate and local Coast Use Permit for P20240673 submitted by Apache Louisiana Minerals” *NO OPPOSTITON, MOTION CARRIED, CHAIRMAN DECLARED MOTION ADOPTED.*
