The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the November 19, 2003 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Houma Zoning Commission** (one vacancy): This group normally meets once a month and the members should be somewhat familiar with zoning regulations in the City of Houma. The members must be residents of the City of Houma.
- **Terrebonne Parish Women's Commission** (one vacancy): The group normally meets once a month and review issues of importance to women and families. Members may be male or female and may live anywhere in Terrebonne Parish.
