#### **Department of Housing & Human Services DRAFT 2025-2029 CONSOLIDATED PLAN and 2025 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government has prepared a draft 5-Year Consolidated Plan and an Annual Action Plan for its 2025 Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnerships Programs as required by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development. All interested parties are invited to review the documents, as well as comment or ask questions. The 5-Year Consolidated Plan addresses identified housing, homeless, and community development needs of Terrebonne Parish, while the Annual Action Plan describes how the anticipated 2025 grant funds will address the identified needs.
