TPCG Awarded Greener Grounds Grant to Support Mardi Gras Cleanup Efforts

Houma, Louisiana – Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government (TPCG) has been awarded the Greener Grounds Grant from Keep Louisiana Beautiful (KLB) for FY25-26 in the amount of \$6,438.00 to support cleanup and sustainability efforts during Mardi Gras.

As the second-largest Mardi Gras destination in Louisiana, Terrebonne Parish hosts more than ten parades over a 2.5-week celebration, welcoming over 10,000 residents and visitors. The Greener Grounds Grant will fund educational signage focused on litter awareness and recycling, as well as cleanup and recycling supplies to help maintain the parade routes before, during, and after events.
