PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR PROGRAM INCOME DISPOSITION FUNDS FROM THE LOUISIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT- DISASTER RECOVERY UNIT

Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government has prepared a Program Income Disposition Application for submission to the Louisiana Office of Community Development – Disaster Recovery Unit. The application requests \$3,000,000.00 to fill a financial gap for the Parkwood Place Affordable Rental Development project. This proposed project will develop ninety units of affordable rental housing that will be located at Superbowl Drive and Saints Circle, Houma, Louisiana 70363. The application will be available for review beginning Monday, September 15, 2025, and ending Tuesday, October 7, 2025. All written comments will be considered by Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government prior to submitting the application to the Louisiana Office of Community Development-Disaster Recovery Unit.
