

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At an upcoming meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be a resident property taxpayer of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area.
- **Fire Protection District No. 8 Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be a resident property taxpayer of Fire District No. 8 District and interested in administration of fire protection services in the area.
- **Hospital Service District No. 1 Board of Commissioners:** (one vacancy representing “civic organizations” until July 31, 2013) Interested individuals must be nominated by any civic organization domiciled in Terrebonne Parish, must be willing to give sufficient time to meetings of the board, and must fill in and submit a specific questionnaire for prospective members of the Hospital Service District No. 1 Board, in addition to the application required of those who wish to serve on Parish-appointed boards.
