

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. *At an upcoming meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to each of the following entities:

- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. (*2/26/14)
- **Coteau Fire Protection District Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers of the Fire District and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. (*2/26/14)
- **Terrebonne Parish Communications District Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must reside within the North Terrebonne Parish area, outside the City Limits of Houma, and be able to attend regularly-scheduled meetings of the board, which oversees the operations of the Enhanced 911 Emergency Response System. (*2/26/14)
- **Terrebonne Parish Tree Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of the Parish, and be able to attend regularly-scheduled meetings of this board. All members shall be qualified voters and residents of the parish and serve without compensation. (*2/26/14)
- **Fire Protection District No. 10 Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers of the Fire District and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. (*2/26/14)
- **South Central Louisiana Human Services Authority Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of Terrebonne Parish and have past experience in the mental health care profession. Meetings are held monthly in various areas of a six-parish region. (*2/26/14)
