The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. *At at upcoming meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to each of the following entities:

Fire District No. 8 Board: One unexpired term. (Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers of the Fire Districts they are applying for and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. *(10/5/16)

Terrebonne Economic Development Authority (TEDA): One expired term, appointed by the Council (African American). *(10/5/16)

Recreation District No. 6 Board: One vacancy. Interested individuals must be a resident of the recreation district and be willing to attend regularly-scheduled meetings to discuss and take action on matters pertaining to recreational facilities and activities therein. *(10/5/16)

Houma Area Convention & Visitors' Bureau: Three expiring terms on 12/21/16. Individuals must be nominated by private, nonprofit group that has an interest in one or more aspects of the tourist industry. *(10/19/16)

Coastal Zone Management & Restoration: Two expiring terms on 10/31/16, representing Marine Navigation and the Oil Industry. Individuals must be interested in coastal zone management issues, and must be willing to make decisions based upon information provided by the Parish's Zone Management and Restoration Department Staff. *(10/19/16)
