

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At a meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** (Two vacancies). Interested individuals must be resident/property owners of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area.
- **Coastal Zone Management and Restoration Advisory Committee:** One vacancy for an individual to represent the commercial fishing industry. Individuals must be interested in coastal zone management issues, and must be willing to make decisions based upon information provided by the Parish's Coastal Restoration Department Director and Staff.
- **Downtown Development Corporation:** (Five vacancies) Two representatives of the public at-large, one representative of Downtown Merchants, one representative of the Chamber of Commerce and one representative of the Enhancement Commission/Keep Terrebonne Beautiful. Interested individuals must be citizens of Terrebonne Parish and interested in the future development of downtown Houma.
- **Houma Area Convention and Visitors' Bureau:** (Two vacancies) One to be nominated by the Historical and Cultural Society, and one to be nominated by a private, non-profit organization whose operations relate to the tourism industry. Qualified individuals should be interested in the promotion of Terrebonne Parish to outside visitors.

A brief resume' and/or letter of interest in serving should also be prepared and submitted.
