- Terrebonne Parish Advisory Committee on Disabilities Affairs: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be Terrebonne Parish residents and interested in improving the quality of life for persons with and families of persons with various disabilities.
- Recreation District No. 6 Board (two expired terms); Interested individuals must be residents of Recreation District No. 1 (Bayou Black, portion of Summerfield area etc.) and interested in the administration of recreation programs.
- Recreation District No. 11 Board (two expired terms); Interested individuals must be residents of Recreation District No. 1 (Urban Services District – City of Houma) and interested in the administration of recreation programs.
