

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with each agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. *At an upcoming meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to each of the following entities:

- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. (*8/14/13)
- **Youth Advisory Council:** Two vacancies - one representing Terrebonne High School and one alternate position for a representative for the area of Northern Terrebonne Parish. Interested individuals must be between the ages of 13 and 18 years of age, or a high school senior. An application form specifically for this board should be obtained from the Office of the Council Clerk via e-mail, FAX, U.S. mail or picked up on the 6th floor of the Government Tower at 8026 Main Street, Houma. - **Bayou Cane Fire Protection District Board:** Two vacancies – Interested individuals must be resident property taxpayers within the Bayou Cane Fire Protection District and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area. (*8/14/13)
- **Houma Board of Zoning Adjustments (Alternate Member):** One vacancy – Interested individuals must be landowners and qualified voters, and must be willing to regularly attend meetings to hear appeals, and to decide upon matters relative to zoning regulations and restrictions when necessary. - **Veterans' Memorial District Board:** Three vacancies – one to be appointed by Parish President Michel H. Claudet; two must be citizens of Terrebonne Parish and must be members in good standing and nominated in writing by the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, the Marine Corps League, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Vietnam Veterans of America, or Chapter 630 of the United Veterans League.
