The agency in need of a member is a governmental organization that requires people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the October 27, 2010 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board: (one vacancy) Interested individuals must be resident/property owners of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area.
- Terrebonne Economic Development Authority: (one position representing the Terrebonne Branch of the NAACP) Interested individuals must be a citizen of Terrebonne Parish and interested in the continued economic development of the parish. The person must be nominated by the local branch of the NAACP.
- Broadmoor Tree Fund Advisory Board: (one vacancy) Interested individual must be a resident of Broadmoor Subdivision and be willing to attend occasional meetings to decide on trees to be removed/trimmed in the subdivision.
