

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the November 16, 2011 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- Broadmoor Tree Fund Committee: (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of Broadmoor Subdivision and interested in the maintenance of the trees in the subdivision.
- Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board: (One vacancy). Interested individuals must be resident/property owners of the Bayou Blue Fire District (Terrebonne Parish side) and interested in the administration of fire protection services in the area.
- Recreation District No. 1 Board: (One vacancy) Interested individuals must be residents of the recreation district and be willing to attend regularly-scheduled meetings to discuss and take action on matters pertaining to recreational facilities and activities therein.
- CZM Advisory Committee: One vacancy representing the public at-large. Individuals must be interested in coastal zone management issues, and must be willing to make decisions based upon information provided by the Parish's Coastal Restoration Department Director and Staff.
- Downtown Development Corporation: Two vacancies, one representative of garden clubs, and one representative of the Historical and Cultural Society. Interested individuals must be citizens of Terrebonne Parish and interested in the future development of downtown Houma.
