The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the January 28, 2009 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- **Board of (Zoning) Adjustments:** (one alternate member position). Interested parties should be residents of the areas included under zoning regulations and available to serve as an alternate board member.
- **Bayou Cane Fire and Protection District Board:** (one expired term) Interested parties should be residents property owners of the Bayou Cane area and interested in the operation of the fire protection district.
- **Fire Protection District No. 8 Board:** (three expired terms) Interested parties should be residents property owners of the Gibson/Donner/Chacahoula area and interested in the operation of the fire protection district.
- **Fire Protection District No. 4 Board:** (two expired terms) Interested parties should be residents property owners of the Grand Caillou community and interested in the operation of the fire protection district.
- **Fire Protection District No. 9 Board:** (two expired terms) Interested parties should be residents property owners of the Bayou Black area and interested in the operation of the fire protection district.
- **Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board:** (one expired term) Interested parties should be residents property owners of the Bayou Blue area and interested in the operation of the fire protection district.
- **Recreation District No. 10 Board:** (one vacancy)) Interested parties should be residents property owners of the Bayou Dularge area and interested in the operation of the local recreation district.
