The Terrebonne Parish Council is seeking individuals to serve on various boards, committees, and commissions designed to maintain and improve the quality of life in our community. The agencies in need of members are governmental or quasi-governmental organizations that require people who are familiar with the agency and are willing to give of their time and talents. At the April 13, 2005 meeting of the Parish Council, individuals are scheduled to be appointed to the following agencies:

- Bayou Blue Fire Protection District Board (one vacancy): Interested citizens must be resident property owners in the district and have an interest in administering the affairs of the fire district.
- Recreation District No. 3 Board (one vacancy): Interested parties should reside in the east Houma portion of the parish outside of the Urban Services District and interested in administering the affairs of the recreation district.
- Recreation District No. 10 Board (one expired term). Interested parties should reside in the Bayou Dularge community and interested in administering the affairs of the recreation district.
