ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform excavation, ditch sloping, construction and sloping of levees, driving pilings, clearing bayous, and insuring proper depth.
2. Insure proper maintenance of equipment such as: oil levels, air filters, lubricants, etc.
3. Supervise work and train assistant in operation of equipment.
4. Load and unload excavator onto low-bay.
5. Use a torch and do some mechanic work to correct minor breakdowns on job site.
6. Assist mechanic in major repair of equipment.
7. Report breakdowns and emergencies to the Operation Supervisor.
8. Analyze work site to ensure equipment can operate properly.
9. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Knowledge of principles of supervision.
2. Read and write sufficiently to fill out reports.
3. Be able to work a tablet or iPad.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED equivalent.
2. Three years of experience in operating excavators.
