- 3. Identify complaint locations; photograph area to confirm and identify violations.
- 4. Illustrate physical complaint locations to assist with ownership and property description research efforts.
- 5. Become familiar with code compliance process and able to complete required reports.
- 6. Become familiar with housing codes to assist owners with compliance efforts.
- 7. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.
