PHYSICAL DEMANDS

WORK ENVIRONMENT

Indoors and outdoors in varying climates and conditions, including exposure to wastewater, chemicals, noise, traffic, etc.

EMERGENCY EVENTS

Required to work during emergency events.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform general maintenance on wastewater system, including gravity mains, manholes, force mains, and lift stations.
2. Perform general maintenance on division buildings, grounds, and equipment.
3. Perform field locations of sewer facilities; assist in smoke testing and video operation.
4. Fill out daily work orders.
5. Perform other duties as assigned by a supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Ability to comprehend the operation of wastewater collection system.
2. Ability to read and interpret written and oral instructions.
3. Possess and maintain a personal phone for call-out purposes.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certificate required.
2. At least one year of labor experience or equivalent required.
3. Possess or be willing to obtain LA DHH-OPH Wastewater Collection III or higher certification.
4. Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana driver's license.
