PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Work indoors and outdoors in varying climates and conditions, including around moving mechanical parts and in high noise areas

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform skilled carpentry tasks in accordance with standard practices and code compliance of the trade.
2. Establish and maintain effective relationships with supervisors and other employees.
3. Inspect materials for quality and grade.
4. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.
2. Possess general knowledge of the standard practices, methods, tools, materials, hazards, and safety precautions of the rehabilitation and weatherization trades.
3. Ability to use tools, materials, and equipment used in the carpentry trade.
4. Possess a thorough understanding of rough carpentry, finish carpentry, and all trades associated with residential repair.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certification required.
2. Minimum of three (3) years of carpentry experience; completion of a recognized apprenticeship may substitute for experience.
3. Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana driver's license.

EQUIPMENT USED

1. Personal protective equipment
2. Mask
3. To include but not limited to all drills, saws, hand tools, squares, levels, and tape measures

EMERGENCY EVENTS

May be required to work during emergency events.
