ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform major repairs on diesel- and gas-powered equipment including air brakes, hydraulic and electrical systems, oil leaks, seals, power takeoffs, injectors, etc.,
2. Perform minor repairs and oil filter changes on low lift diesel pumps and minor engine overhauls. Regularly visit pump stations to ensure efficient operation and complete maintenance schedule on each parish pump.
3. Drive to job site locations to repair equipment.
4. Complete work orders on any repairs made, and maintain all inventory necessary for repairs.
5. Notify supervisor when parts are needed, and pick up parts from vendors as needed.
6. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

7. Must be capable of following all applicable safety rules and regulations.
8. Must have effective written and oral communication skills and be able to follow oral and written instructions.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certificate required.
2. Minimum of three years of experience as a mechanic.
3. Possess and maintain valid Louisiana driver's license.
