ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Keep Transit amenities in safe condition and with a good appearance.
2. Assist in the maintenance and repair of transit amenities such as shelters, benches, signs, etc.
3. Maintain equipment and tools used for maintenance work.
4. Install and move transit amenities, and install, change, and repair advertising signs.
5. Clean, paint, and perform minor repairs to transit facilities and amenities.
6. Pick up trash, empty trash receptacles, and control plant growth at bus stops and stations.
7. Lift and manipulate heavy components and supplies.
8. Assist in cleaning, washing, and maintaining interior and exterior of transit vehicles.
9. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Possess mechanical repair knowledge.
2. Be willing to practice safe work habits and attend regular safety meetings.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school graduate or GED certification desired.
2. Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana driver's license with a safe driving record.
