## ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Work with the operations supervisor to ensure sufficient personnel, equipment, and material are on hand at all times.
2. Prepare incident reports for Human Resources and Risk Management.
3. Prepare and maintain equipment maintenance records.
4. Perform general maintenance and minor repairs on equipment, including diesel- and gas-powered equipment as needed.
5. Operate grapple truck, roll-off truck, and street sweeper.
6. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Ability to learn and practice all applicable safety rules and regulations.
2. Ability to perform tasks without direct supervision.
3. Ability to operate excavators, trash compactors, dozers, front end loaders, articulated dump trucks, dump trucks, shredder, pickup trucks, tractors, tools, phones, and any other equipment required to perform job duties.
4. Ability to supervise assigned employees.

## EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certificate required.
2. Minimum of three years of appropriate experience operating heavy equipment or related duties.
3. Possess and maintain a valid Class B commercial driver's license (CDL).
