ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Monitor facilities during activities and serve as the on-site representative of the Department of Quality of Life.
2. Assist with ensuring equipment and supplies are available and in good working condition.
3. Ensure all rules, policies, and procedures are followed to create a safe and healthy working environment.
4. Address issues, problems, and concerns during facility use in a polite and professional manner, and report any issues to the Quality of Life Administration on or before the next business day.
5. Perform custodial duties to maintain cleanliness and sanitary conditions, including general cleaning of facilities and restrooms, sweeping and mopping, picking up trash and debris, emptying and sanitizing trash containers, etc.
6. Assist with basic maintenance repairs to facilities and equipment.
7. Assist with event setup/tear down.
8. Perform other other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Ability to work independently.
2. Familiarity with safety and operations fo small hand and power tools.
3. Take any trainings or obtain any required certifications.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certification required.
2. Prior experience is a plus.
3. Possess and maintain valid Louisiana driver's license with a good driving record.
