ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Perform semi-skilled work in the maintenance of plant equipment, vehicles, machinery, and/or other equipment utilizing hand and power tools.
2. Perform general maintenance work on all equipment in conjunction with established maintenance schedules, requests, and on an as needed basis.
3. Perform ground maintenance and temporarily replace other mechanics when required.
4. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.
5. Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Possess and maintain a personal phone for emergency call-out purposes.
2. Ability to comprehend the mechanics and operational procedures of wastewater treatment plant and associated equipment.
3. Ability to read and interpret written and oral instructions.
4. Learn and practice applicable safety rules and regulations.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

1. High school diploma or GED certificate required.
2. Possess any required state certifications in wastewater collection or be willing to obtain as needed.
3. Possess or be willing to obtain LA DHH-OPH Wastewater Collection III or higher certification.
4. Possess and maintain a valid Louisiana driver's license; Class B commercial driver's license (CDL) with air brakes preferred.
