ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Operate equipment spreading solid waste into trailers and clean bay areas.
- Clean pickup station.
- Perform general maintenance and minor repairs on assigned equipment.
- Prepare and maintain records required for equipment maintenance.
- Assist in repairing diesel- and gas-powered equipment as directed.
- Pick up litter as directed.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Learn and practice all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- Ability to operate electric hydraulic knuckle boom, trash compactors, front end loaders, pickup trucks, tractors, tools, telephone, and any other required equipment safely and efficiently.
- Possess good working knowledge of assigned equipment.
- Willing to learn how to operate other heavy equipment to relieve or substitute at C&D.
- Ability to supervise employees assigned to assist in equipment maintenance and repair.
- Ability to perform duties without direct supervision.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND LICENSES

- High school diploma or equivalency certificate preferred.
- Minimum of one year of appropriate experience in operating heavy equipment or related field required.
- Possess and maintain valid Louisiana driver's license.
