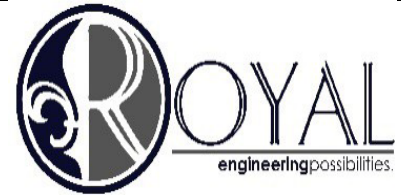

The purpose of this contract is to rehabilitate the asphalt roadway and limestone shoulder along Shrimpers Row between Combon Bridge and Buquet Bridge.

1.7 TIME TO COMPLETION

The time to completion for this project is 60 calendar days. Inclement weather will not, in and of itself, be construed as an automatic cause for time extension.

1.8 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

\$500.00/calendar day

1.9 DATE OF NOTICE TO PROCEED

1.10 CONSTRUCTION MEETINGS

Bi-weekly progress meetings will be held. Schedule to be determined.

1.11 UNAVOIDABLE DELAYS

The CONTRACTOR is to advise the OWNER/ENGINEER of any known unavoidable delays at this time and at any point during the project. These items should be brought to the attention of the OWNER and ENGINEER.

1.12 CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Before beginning work on the project, the CONTRACTOR shall submit to the

engineer a Construction Progress Schedule giving a satisfactory schedule of operations that provides for completion of the work within the contract time. This schedule shall be on the prescribed bar graph form.

1.13 SAFETY, HEALTH AND SANITARY PROVISIONS

The CONTRACTOR shall not require any worker to work under conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous or dangerous to health or safety. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain the work in a sanitary, safe and nonhazardous condition.

The CONTRACTOR shall provide and maintain in a neat, sanitary condition, restrooms and other such accommodations for use of employees and ENGINEER or OWNER personnel. Such facilities shall comply with requirements of the State and local Boards of Health or other bodies or tribunals having jurisdiction.

The CONTRACTOR shall establish a regular daily collection of all sanitary and organic wastes. All wastes and refuse from sanitary facilities provided by the CONTRACTOR or organic material wastes from any other source related to the CONTRACTOR's operations shall be disposed of away from the Site in a manner satisfactory to the ENGINEER and in accordance with all laws and regulations pertaining thereto.

1.14 PROTECTION OF EXISTING UTILITIES

The CONTRACTOR is responsible for the protection of existing utilities. (no direct pay)

1.15 BARRICADES AND WARNING SIGNS

The CONTRACTOR shall provide, erect and maintain necessary barricades, suitable lights, danger signals, signs and other traffic control devices, including flaggers, and shall take all necessary precautions for protection of the work and safety of the public. Highways closed to traffic shall be protected by effective barricades. Suitable warning signs shall be provided to direct traffic. Billed per each location.

1.16 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Contractor to comply with DOTD standards and specifications.

1.17 TEMPORARY UTILITIES

The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the provision of all temporary utilities he deems necessary for the proper execution of the WORK in the most efficient manner practical. The cost of provision of these temporary utilities shall be borne by the CONTRACTOR and shall be included in the price of the WORK.

1.18 SITE ACCESS AND STORAGE

The CONTRACTOR shall make its own investigation of the condition of available public and private roads and of clearances, restrictions, bridge load limits, and other limitations affecting transportation and ingress and egress to the site of the WORK. It shall be the CONTRACTOR's responsibility to construct and maintain any haul roads if required for its construction operations.

1.19 SITE CONDITIONS SURVEYS – Contractor Responsibility.

1.20 PROTECTION OF THE WORK

The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the protection of the site, and all WORK, materials, equipment and existing facilities thereon, against theft, vandals, and other unauthorized persons.

1.21 WORKING HOURS

No work shall be done before sunrise and after sunset, or legal holidays without permission of OWNER. However, emergency work may be done without prior permissions. All work shall be performed only during daylight hours unless approved by the OWNER.

CONTRACTOR can request in writing to work outside the specified work hours, and owner holidays and weekend work. No work shall occur outside the specified hours and owner holidays, without prior OWNER approval in writing.

1.22 SPECIAL ITEMS

The CONTRACTOR's use of the Site shall be limited to its construction operations, including on-Site storage of materials, on-Site fabrication facilities, and field offices.

The OWNER shall be allowed access to the Site during the period of construction.
